

On the by-laws ballot below, please vote to either approved or disapprove. We have intentionally developed the by-laws so that they can be changed or amended by the membership without much difficulty. For example, as per the by-laws, only 5% of the membership are needed to propose a change to the by-laws. At the reunions, with only 10% of the active membership present or represented by proxy, the membership can change these by-laws by majority vote.
